Applicants to the Ph.D Program-2023 (Phase-I) of Department of Slavonic & Finno-Ugrian Studies are required to appear for the Interview Process to be considered for admission. Applicants must bring along two passport size photographs and self-attested copies of the following documents along with the originals at the time of the Interview:

1. Proof of identity (e.g. Aadhaar card/ Voter ID card/ PAN card/ Driving license)
2. Date of birth certificate / Class X certificate mentioning date of birth
3. Undergraduate Exam Marksheet and certificate (Including CGPA to percentage conversion table)
4. Postgraduate Exam Marksheet and certificate (Including CGPA to percentage conversion table)
5. UGC/ NET-JRF certificate/ other notified fellowships (if applicable)
6. Reservation Claim Certificates (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD) (if any)
7. 08 Copies of proposal

Note:

1. The candidates must ensure that they fulfill all eligibility criteria.
2. At the time of admission, they must produce in original all relevant and valid documents in support of the eligibility conditions and other details mentioned in their application form.
